- 2. I GIVE and BEQUEATH my jewellery and articles of personal use or ornament to such of my nieces Kathleen Smith Pauline Gillian Maw and Sarah Jacqueline Maw as shall survive me and if more than on in equal shares to be divided amongst them as they shall agree and if my said nieces are unable to agree as to such division then <u>I DIRECT</u> my Trustee to sell my said jewellery and articles of personal use or ornament and divide the net proceeds of such sale equally between such of my said nieces as shall survive me in equal shares.
- 3. <u>I GIVE and BEQUEATH</u> my share and all other my estate and interest of and in the proceeds of sale of the dwelling house situate in Friarwood Pontefract aforesaid in which I now reside and the nursery gardens adjoining in the occupation of "H.H. Maw & Son" to which I am entitled under the Will of my late Father <u>UNTO</u> MY nephew Walter Senior Maw for his own absolute use and benefit.
- <u>4.</u> <u>I GIVE and BEQUEATH</u> all my real and residuary personal estate unto my Trustee upon trust to sell call in and convert the same into money with power to postpone the sale calling in and conversion thereof without being liable for loss and to hold the net proceeds of such sale and my ready money upon the following trusts:-
- (a) <u>Upon</u> Trust to pay thereout all my just debts testamentary and funeral expenses.
- (b) Upon Trust to divide the remainder after such payment between all my newphews and nieces except the said

Walter Senior Maw who shall survive me and attain the age of Twenty one years in equal shares.

<u>5.</u> <u>I DECLARE</u> that in case any nephew or niece of mine shall die in my lifetime leaving issue living at my death who being male attain the age of Twenty one years or being female attain that age or previously marry such issue shall stand in the place of such deceased nephew or niece and take per stirpes and equally between them if more than one any share or interest under this my Will which such deceased nephew or niece would have taken if he or she had survived me and attained a vested interest.
