This is the last Will and Testament of me John Henry Shawe Mansie Esq a Lieutenant in His Majesty's or sixth Regiment of Foot Guards first I desire that all just debts legacies and funeral expences and the charges of proving this my will may be paid by my Executors hereinafter named as soon as conveniently may be after my decease and I give and bequeath unto my dear and honored father John Henry Mansie and my dear wife Richard Henry Shovin the sum of one hundred quincas cast and whereas the said John Henry Mansie my father in consideration of my consenting to join with him in suffering a conveyance of certain Estates comprised in the Dots of settlement made previous to his marriage with my late Mother deceased did in and by a certain bond or obligation in writing bearing date on or about the twentieth day of October one thousand eight hundred and four become bound to me my Executors Administrators and Assigns in the sum of twelve thousand pounds with a condition hereunder written that if the said John Henry Mansie his Executors administrators or assigns should pay unto me during his natural life the yearly sum of one hundred pounds at the times and in manner therein mentioned and in case the said John Henry Mansie should at any time hereafter sell and dispose of all or any part of the said Estates under or by virtue of the said conveyance then if as his heirs Executors or Administrators should immediately after such sale and disposal pay unto me during his natural life the further yearly sum of one hundred pounds at the times and in manner therein also mentioned And also if the said heirs Executors or Administrators of him the said John Henry Mansie should within twelve months next after his decease pay unto me the sum of six thousand pounds with lawful interest for the same subject notwithstanding to such conditions as are particularly mentioned in the said bond or obligation that then the said obligation should be void Now I give and bequeath all and every the sum or sums of Money which at the time of my decease shall be due and owing or payable to me or upon or by virtue of the said written bond or obligation together with all and every other sum or sums of money and personal Estate of what kind or nature soever and whatsoever which at the time of my decease I may be possessed of or entitled unto unto my brothers and sisters Richard Shovin Mansie Thomas Mansie George Mansie Frederick Mansie Margaret Mansie Dorothy Mansie and Sarah Rhodes Mansie or such of them as shall be living at the time of my decease equally to be divided between or among them share and share alike the share or shares of my said brothers to be paid and payable to them upon their attaining the age or respective ages of twenty one years and the share or shares of my said sisters to be paid or payable to them upon their attaining that age or being married which shall first happen But if any of my said brothers shall die under the age of twenty one years or any of my said sisters shall die under that age and unmarried in that case and from thenceforth I give and bequeath as well the original share as every other share or part of them so dying of and in all and every such sum or sums of money as aforesaid unto the survivors of them equally to be divided between or amongst them if more than one share and share alike and if there shall be only one who being a brother shall live to attain the age of twenty one years or being a sister shall live to attain that age or marry whether shall first happen then for such surviving brother or sister as the case may be and his her or their Executors and Administrators provided always and it is my will and in mind and I do hereby direct that if any of my said brothers or sisters shall happen to die in my lifetime leaving a wife or children who being a son or daughter shall live to attain the age of twenty one years or being a son daughter or daughters shall live to attain that age or marry that then and in such case the share or shares of and in the said several sums or sums of money as aforesaid which shall be due and owing
