I Daniel Rogers of Sinter, hertfordshire, with in the parish of St. Clares in the Citie of London of quier, one of the Clerke of her majestie moste honorable privie counsell, Sirke of bodie, but of perfect seure and remembrance Doe constitute and ordaine this my laste will and testament in manner and forme followinge: viz ffirste I comitt my soule to the handes and protection of all mightie god, and my bodie to be buried with in the parish church of St. Clares aforeseide. Item I give and bequeath to my brother John Rogers Doctor of the civile lawe a peere of my plate. Item I bequeath to Ambrose Rogers my youngeste brother the summe of Twentie poundes of Lawfull and currant Englishe monie. Item I give and bequeath to ffrauncis Rogers my son and to his heires all my Landes and Tenementes with, thappurtenances as well furth as I holde from her majestie in fee farme ad bys. Lease with in the Countie of Salop, reservinge unto Susan Rogers my wife her estate in the Mannors of Linnerton and Kilton, parts of my saide Landes, in the Countie of Salop, allwaie assured unto her and the heirs of heres of my saide son ffrauncis and other issue of my bodie, wthout maner please god to send me my saide wife beinge at this presente greater with child: my will and meaninge is, that the remainder of my saide Mannors of Kilton and Oldonie shall descende and come to my saide brother John and Ambrose Rogers, and to thaire heires, equally to be divided betwix them. And that the residue of all the peeres of the lease of Linnerton and Kilton aforeseide, for waite of such issue as aforeseide, to remaine to the saide Susan Rogers my wife and to her heires for ever. Item I doe hereby constitute and appointe my saide wife to be Guardian of my saide son, and to receive and take unto her due use, the commodities and profits of all my saide Landes, until my saide son shall come to the age of twentie one yeeres. And because the saide Susan Rogers my wife is nowe with child, I doe hereby will and ordaine that out of the revenues and commodities of my saide Landes, she shall have yearly payde and allowed unto him, after he shall be of the age of one and twentie yeeres, the summe of five poundes of Lawfull and currant Englishe monie duringe his naturall life. And if he shall please god that my saide wife shall be delivered of a daughter, I appointe ordaine and bequeath by the said presente, that my saide wife shall paye unto her the summe of three hundred poundes of like Englishe monie, at such time as she shall be able to attaine unto the yeeres of fifteen or at the daie of her marriage, wthout fail. Item I doe hereby nominate constitute ordaine and appointe the saide Susan Rogers my wife to be full and sole executrix of this my laste will and testament to discharge my legacies therein bequeathed. And because to her owne use and behoofe, all my goodes movable and immovable, thattall, debted lease bills or bondes of debte and all other thinges wth either doe maie or oughte to appertaine unto me, And doe appointe willielm woades of quier, one of the clerke of her majestie privie counsell, and my saide brother John Rogers to be overseers of this my laste will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hande and scale the tenth daie of february in the first and thirthe yeeres of the reign of our soueraigne Ladie Elizabeth by the grace of god Queene of Englands ffraunce and Irelande Defendesse of the faithfull.
